Using the Solea Laser to perform lingual and maxillary frenectomies helps to solve a variety of problems including breastfeeding issues and speech difficulties.

The Solea Laser is a CO2 all-tissue dental laser used for soft tissue surgeries. The laser produces a very narrow, intense beam of light energy that when it comes into contact with tissue can remove or reshape the tissue.

The Solea Laser means treatments are faster, more precise, and do not require anesthesia. As a result, procedures result in less bleeding, minimal swelling, no sutures, and almost no discomfort. There is also less chance of bacterial infections.

Using the Solea Laser to perform a frenectomy is ideal because the procedure is less invasive and quick?with patients experiencing little bleeding and discomfort. With a traditional frenectomy, anesthesia is required, and the procedure can take 10 to 15 minutes. Utilizing the Solea Laser, the entire procedure can be performed in 30 to 60 seconds?without the need for anesthesia.

?Using the Solea Laser is the most comfortable, fastest, and easiest way to complete a frenectomy,? said Dr. Derek Hauser. ?The healing period is much faster and easier than traditional methods for frenectomies.?

A lingual frenectomy is typically performed on infants with tongue ties. Tongue ties happen when the lingual frenulum (the thin tissue that connects the tongue to the bottom of the mouth) is too short?thereby limiting the tongue?s ability to move and making it difficult to swallow or speak. In infants, this can lead to breastfeeding problems. In children or adults, tongue ties can result in speech difficulties, jaw pain, or underbites.

Tongue ties occur in approximately 5% of babies, are more prevalent in males than females, and tend to run in families. Tongue ties often occur with lip ties. Patients are considered ?lip tied? when the labial frenulum (the tissue that attaches to the upper lip to the gums) is very tight or large.

Lip ties make it difficult to move the upper lip. This can lead to breastfeeding difficulties, speech problems, gaps between front teeth, and difficulties cleaning teeth and gums. The procedure to correct lip ties is called a maxillary frenectomy.

The Solea laser is also used for periodontal disease treatment and gum disease at this private dentist office in Lake Elsinore, as well as tooth fillings.
