

Senior Care Center Is Drawing Attention To The Efforts To Battle COVID-19 In San Clemente, California

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Senior Care Center is drawing attention to the efforts that the local government and organizations have put in place to battle the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic in San Clemente, a city in Orange County, California.

The Dorothy Visser Senior Center, a senior care center operated by Age Well Senior Services, is located in downtown San Clemente. The center has a fitness room, holds classes and programs, provides special services, and has daily lunches. The Dorothy Visser Senior Center has been closed due to the efforts surrounding COVID-19 since March 16, 2020. For updates on operations, readers can contact the center at (949) 498-3322. Meal delivery and pick-up services remain available for those in need.

Age Well Senior Services is a nonprofit organization that provides services, resources, and programs to seniors living in South Orange County. These include meal services, transportation, Senior Center activities and programs, case management, and health and wellness services. Age Well Senior Services is working with several restaurants and caterers to deliver tasty, healthy meals as a

part of the Senior Cuisine Delivered program. Seniors can choose between 4, 8, or 12 meal weekly plans. Meal orders placed before 12 noon on Friday begin the following Monday.

The San Clemente Senior Mobility Program is a free service that provides San Clemente residents age 60 and over with transportation between their residences and selected San Clemente grocery stores and the Dorothy Visser Senior Center in San Clemente. Due to the COVID pandemic, rides to the Senior Center have been discontinued until further notice. The Senior Mobility Program will continue to provide grocery store ride services at this time, with expanded morning hours from 6:30 AM (normally 8 AM) to 2:30 PM, from Monday through Thursday.

San Clemente Village is a local nonprofit, volunteer-based, member organization. The Village was created in 2015 to bring local residents age 55 and over together, to support one another, and to enjoy an active, connected, and independent life. Village volunteers provide services in the home that can make life easier. Screened and trained volunteers, provide services such as transportation, pet assistance, handyman needs, and technical assistance to name a few. General resource information is also available. In addition, Village members have access to a wide array of social and educational opportunities including yoga, bridge, dine around groups, theatre outings, and cooking classes. There have been 252,804 cumulative cases of COVID-19 in Orange County so far. 595,450 people have received one dose of the 2-Dose vaccines (the vaccines from Pfizer and Moderna) whereas 687,552 people have been fully vaccinated. 65,611 people have received the dose of the 1-Dose vaccine (the vaccine from Johnson & Johnson). There has been an improvement in the COVID-19 situation with a reduction of the County risk level from ?Substantial? to ?Moderate?. In accordance with the ?Moderate? risk level, some indoor business operations are allowed to open with modifications.

Senior Care Center is an organization that provides online resources to seniors and families who are looking for COVID-safe senior care homes such as nursing homes and assisted living facilities for themselves or their elderly family members. The center boasts a strong network of Senior Care Advisors who guide the families and seniors about the best option among all the senior care homes in the desired location.
