OASIS Transporation is providing curb-to-curb transportation to essential appointments from Monday to Friday from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM by appointment only to Newport Beach residents over 60.

Those who are looking for someone to talk to about the challenges they are facing can sign up to receive a daily phone call from a friendly OASIS volunteer to check-in and chat for a while. To be added to the call list,

The City of Newport Beach is working closely with Orange County on distribution plans for the COVID-19 vaccine. It says that it is committed to providing resources to support the vaccination effort. The distribution process is developing rapidly and all relevant updates will be posted on the website as they arise.

As of April 11, 2021, 595,450 people have received one dose of the 2-dose vaccines (Pfizer and Moderna) while 687,552 have been fully vaccinated. 65,611 people have received the dose of the 1-dose vaccine (Johnson & Substantial? to ?Moderate? based on the progress of the vaccine administration and the improvement of patient statistics. Currently, in accordance with the ?Moderate? risk level, some indoor business operations are allowed to open with modifications.
