In fact, a septic tank that is near capacity should be pumped during the spring to avoid flooding from heavy spring rain showers. Make sure your tank is pumped this spring season, especially if your tank has not been pumped for the last three to five years, there is water pooling in the yard, there are offensive smells, drains are slow, or there is sewage backup."

For homeowners who can't remember the last time the system was last pumped, they recommend that they schedule their tanks to be pumped this spring. Those who notice random water pooling in their yard, or the presence of luxurious green grass near their septic tank and drain field, are also advised to have their tank pumped because these are signs of septic tank leakage. And if there are foul odors emanating from drains inside the home or in the yard, these could possibly be the result of sewage backups or the septic tank being almost full.

Another possible indication of the need to have the tank pumped is that the drains are slow. Slow drains may be a sign that the tank is almost full. And finally, the most obvious sign of a potential septic tank problem is raw sewage backing up into the house. Sewage backup is certainly not a pleasant experience, not to mention its negative health impact on the people living in the home. Homeowners are strongly advised to consult professionals like the septic tank specialists from Commonwealth Waste Solutions as quickly as possible to have their septic system inspected to determine the actual cause of the sewage backup.
