As the weather in Houston begins to creep higher, taking the humidity with it, understanding key maintenance points can make for a much more comfortable summer.

Certainly, one of the absolute most user-friendly ways a home or business owner can lengthen the life of their HVAC system is by changing the air filter. Although many folks assume that air filter changes are difficult and require professional HVAC experience, this idea couldn't be farther from the truth.

"Changing up the system filter is actually a very inexpensive and doable task, even for the homeowner that lacks technical know-how," said Donald Compton, owner and spokesperson for Air Check Mechanical Service, one of Houston's best rated Air Conditioning Service companies. "We find that if you can get the customer curious about their HVAC system, they are more likely to do simple things like change the filter, which means that their system lasts."

As noted in the article, HVAC air filters work very well, but after a while, a clogged filter can stress the air conditioner or furnace, which can add up over time.

Another important maintenance item that home and business owners in Houston should definitely check and explore is the evaporator coils. When air circulation inside a central air conditioning unit is somehow constrained or blocked, the evaporator coils can actually get too cold, and form thin layers of ice. This situation can create a problem with the unit blowing only warm or hot air, as the coils are not able to perform their tasks properly.

Additionally, AC maintenance checks performed by professionals like those at Air Check may also uncover issues like a lack of refrigerant, without which the air conditioner simply cannot run effectively. Although refrigerant leaks can suggest a much larger issue, often they are quite small and can be addressed quickly

and easily.

One of the most important considerations for people with relatively consistent issues with their central air conditioning is often the capacity of the unit itself. Often, unprofessional or unlicensed HVAC contractors may sell and install HVAC systems that attract customers with low price, but may be the incorrect size for the building. It's a problem that happens more often than most people think is possible.

"When you have an HVAC contractor that is operating out of a truck, and has little in the way of a local following or a real company working for you, you can run into real problems," says Compton, who has over 17 years of experience as an HVAC contractor. "It doesn't always happen, but in the cases where the system is the incorrect size, the customer often ends up paying 200% of the original install just to correct issues. Basically, working with a non-professional can end up being far more expensive in the long run."

The simplest way for Houston HVAC customers to always stay on top of their system and ensure that its maintenance is regularly checked is to set up a maintenance agreement with an air conditioning service like Air Check Mechanical Service. Having a professional examine an HVAC system at least twice a year is the best way to ensure it is smooth running, provides consistent comfort and doesn't create any unfortunate surprises or require repairs.
