



Need for Improvements in Drivers Ed Education Stressed as Pennsylvania Aims for Zero Traffic Deaths

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Improving driver's education is vital as the state of Pennsylvania aims for zero traffic deaths in view of 2020 having the second lowest number of traffic fatalities on record. The year 2019 actually had the lowest number of traffic deaths in Pennsylvania on record, which was 1,059. In 2020, there was an increase in the traffic fatalities to 1,129. It is still a puzzle why the traffic deaths were higher in 2020 compared to 2019 despite the approximately 20 percent decline in traffic in 2020 due to the pandemic.
