Natural Lice Removal Products And Tools Are Safest And Most Effective, Says Boston-Area Head Lice Removal Professionals

NitWits, the Boston area's oldest premier head lice treatment service, today stated that a widely used insecticide commonly found in many over-the-counter lice shampoos may increase the risk for cardiovascular disease and early death. Furthermore, the salon's founder states that head lice have become resistant to many ingredients in drugstore lice removal brands, and that the best way to treat head lice is to use a lice comb and products derived from natural ingredients as they stop the growth cycle by physically removing lice and nits from the scalp.

"Pyrethrin and its synthetic derivatives are common insecticides used in lice shampoos that are potentially harmful to children's health," states founder Berit Pratt, RN BSN MPH. "Lice treatments containing pesticides can be absorbed into the child's bloodstream after they're applied to the scalp, then metabolized and

excreted in the urine. Furthermore, these chemicals, when effective, will only kill adult head lice. They won't kill the eggs, which will continue to hatch and prolong the infestation."

Pratt received her Masters in Public Health studying Pesticides and Childhood Cancers from the BU School of Public Health. As a school nurse, she has observed that chemical pesticides such as Pyrethrin used in over-the-counter head lice removal products are no longer effective, as lice have developed resistance to them. She also discovered that many NitWits clients used several drugstore lice treatment brands and prescriptions yet were still experiencing robust cases of lice in their households.

Pratt recommends using a head lice comb to mechanically remove lice and nits from hair strands, thus stopping the head lice growth cycle.

"Parents have been led to believe that there is a quick fix for lice," she explains. "Everyone wants a magic bullet to take care of lice quickly. However, it is impossible to get rid of lice without actually removing the nits from the hair. Adult head lice attach the nits, or eggs, to the hair shaft like super-glue. This makes the nits incredibly hard to remove and they are very hard to see. Head lice have spent hundreds, thousands of years developing a very effective camouflage so that we humans cannot see them or their eggs. This is why it is important to use a good lice comb to treat head lice at home."
