According to the roofing contractor, an overlay isn't always ideal. It could void or shorten the manufacturer's warranty on roofing materials, and it won't work for all types of roofing materials.

"Overlays also tend to increase future replacement costs since multiple layers have to be removed the next time around," adds Gentry, suggesting homeowners check their homeowners' insurance to see if that might cover roof damages. It is wise to speak to the insurance provider to determine how much they might be willing to cover.

When you begin speaking to roofing contractors, know that installation and disposal fees should be included in your estimate.

Get A Free Estimate

If you've noticed a leak or things are starting to look worse for wear, you should speak to a local roofing company. Most roofing contractors offer free estimates and will lay out a detailed report to let you know whether you need a simple repair, or if you need a replacement. But make sure you get more than one estimate. It's good to get at least 2-3 estimates so that you know that you are getting a fair estimate.

Shop Around

Continuing off the point above, you should always shop around and speak to multiple roofers. Unless you live in a very small town, there should be several options available to you. Always check local references before hiring your local roofer as well. Beware of extremely low bids, which typically lead to low-quality work. You should also be sure your roofer offers a warranty on materials and installation. And the last step you should take before hiring your roofer is to check your local building department to confirm the roofers are properly licensed and insured.

Check the Warranty

Do you know when the last time your roof was replaced, or if it has ever been replaced? If it has been replaced recently, it might still be under warranty. If you recently purchased your home, look over your closing paperwork because warranty information is usually in the fine print. If you can't find this information, contact the previous owner or your real estate agent to see if they have it. If your roof is under warranty, your replacement costs may be covered, so it's definitely worth looking into.

Will An Overlay Work?

An overlay means you install new shingles directly on top of the old ones. This requires fewer labor hours and costs less than a complete replacement because you don't have to remove your old roof. An overlay isn't always ideal because it could void or shorten your manufacturer's warranty on the roofing materials, and it won't work for all types of roofing materials.
