If you think that you have used it for all it's worth, then it probably is time to upgrade to a newer, more efficient unit."

There are also a few evaluations that can be done to determine a system's remaining lifetime. A specialist can do a check on the coils or the blower motor of the unit to see if they are still in working condition. If they are fine and yet the unit is still having difficulties reaching the home's desired temperature, then there may be more problems in the system than just a single component or two. As repair prices can ramp up rapidly and add up to be equivalent to that of a new unit, homeowners should keep track of any possible expenditure before making a commitment.

The system's age is also an important factor to consider when thinking about buying a replacement. EnergyStar recommends replacing an AC unit every 10 to 15 years, though this can vary greatly depending on the kind of workload and stress that the unit is put through. Some of the more durable models can easily

go for the full 15 years with proper maintenance and a moderate workload. Other systems can struggle to make it to their first decade without needing constant repairs, and even if they do, their efficiency can be greatly impaired.

Another aspect to consider is time. New system installations can take a few days, depending on the size of the home or building, the type of installation, type of unit and location of the install. Throughout the process, there will be an entire team of HVAC maintenance professionals working in the house around the clock, which may be inconvenient for some people. There may also be a long waiting list before they can schedule an appointment in the first place.
