In this case, tenure of employment is very important.

If possible, provide proof that rent has always been paid on time and there is no violation of a previous lease or rental agreement. Furthermore, a landlord will be better able to make an informed decision if they know why the debtor was forced into bankruptcy, for instance, because of the pandemic.
