The Caribbean region even encompasses some parts of mainland South and Central America because of their political and cultural ties with the region. This includes Belize, the Caribbean region of Colombia, the Venezuelan Caribbean, Quintana Roo in Mexico (consisting of Cozumel and the Caribbean coast of the Yucatán Peninsula) and The Guianas (Guyana, Suriname, French Guiana, Guayana Region in Venezuela and Amapá in Brazil).

Considering the wide range of land and sea that is considered part of the Caribbean region, it is no surprise that there are many beautiful sights to be experienced within the Caribbean. It is the stunning beauty of the Caribbean that makes it one of the most popular tourist destinations in the world. However, visiting the Caribbean is not an option for everyone and certainly not viable during the current global situation, which is
