Dental veneers are a cosmetic dentistry procedure recommended to patients who want to fix imperfections with their smile by covering teeth that are discolored, chipped, misaligned, or crooked. Veneers are less intrusive compared to crowns or braces and the patient doesn?t have to wait for months for the results to start showing.

There are two kinds of veneers that are commonly recommended in dental practice. First, there are composite veneers that are made of resin. Composite veneers offer the advantage of time and cost as they can be installed in one setting and usually cost less compared to porcelain veneers. However, they have a lower lifespan as they need replacing within 4 to 8 years. Composite veneers also don?t look as natural and they stain just like regular teeth.

The other option that most dentists usually recommend is porcelain dental veneers. They are thin sheets of

porcelain that are bonded to the surface of the teeth. They can dramatically improve the size and color of the teeth they are attached to. They usually require two appointments. In the first appointment, the dentist removes a thin layer of enamel from the teeth. This creates a rougher, better surface for the veneer to bond to. The dentist will then take impressions of the teeth and send them to a lab to create the porcelain veneers. The process requires just a small amount of drilling and absolutely no anesthesia is needed.

In the second appointment, the dentist will show the patient the veneers, hold them in place, and ask the patient to make sure they are happy with their look before proceeding. The dentist will also check the patient?s bite and make minor alterations as required. Once the patient confirms the fit of the veneers, the dentist will thoroughly clean the teeth to remove contaminants. The dentist will then apply a gel to the tooth to act as a bonding agent. Then cement is placed on the back of the porcelain veneer and it is put in place. Once the veneer is in position, a curing light is used to harden the bond.

Porcelain dental veneers are very strong and are known to last for around 10 to 15 years. They are undetectable to the naked eye and pass off as natural teeth with ease as porcelain is the closest equivalent to their sheen, look, and feel. They can withstand reasonable force and are comfortable for the patient to wear. They are also stain resistant which makes them the best choice for someone who complains about staining from consumption of tea, wine, or coffee, and smoking.

Patients in the market for cosmetic dentistry may also have come across the option of teeth replacement in the form of dental implants and crowns. Dental implants are surgical implants that are installed in place of a missing tooth. A crown is a cap that is placed on an existing broken tooth. Though they have their own benefits, they are not required in most cases as veneers can do a great job on their own to restore the elusive smile that most patients are chasing.

Dental implants tend to be more expensive than veneers as installing them is a much more involved process, requiring more time and resources on part of the dental technician. Moreover, not everyone who is looking for smile restoration may be eligible for dental implants. Dental crowns also need to be replaced at a much higher rate than veneers as they go through wear and tear.
