The video features scenic and iconic locations from around the country such as downtown Bucharest, Alba Iulia Fortress, Bran Castle, the castle that inspired the legend of Dracula, Arcul de Triumf in Bucharest, the river Dorna in Vatra Dornei, Fortress Hill, view from the Vidraru Dam, Bigar Waterfall in Oravita, the Bicz Gorge, a gorge in Cheile Bicazului-Hasmas National Park, Orthodox Cathedral in Alba Iulia, the Parang Mountains, Transylvania, villages in Moldavia, a village in Bukovina, a mining community near the city of Petrila, the Carpathian Mountains, near Petrosani city, Jiu Valley, farmland around Chico, a lighthouse in Mangalia, city of Petrila, Lake Bicz, and many more.

The video features stunning views of the country?s landscape such as forests, waterfalls, curving roads, rocky mountains, alpine pastures, vineyards, farmland, gloomy hills, cityscapes, and villages, just to name a few. The video employs high-tech techniques such as panoramic shots to immerse the viewer in the beauty of the Romanian cities and the countryside.

There are plenty of locations around the country that can tickle the fancy of any visitor who is planning to visit, regardless of whether they are interested in natural wonders, or whether they are keen on soaking up the local history. The country is home to the Sc?ri?oara Glacier, found underneath the Bihor Mountains. It is the second-largest underground glacier in Europe. The popular resorts of Mamaia and others on the shore of the Black Sea offer an opportunity to cool off in the hot summer months. For the winter, there are popular skiing resorts along the Valea Prahovei and in Poiana Bra?ov. More than 1.9 million foreign tourists visited Romania in 2014, over three-fourths of whom came from other parts of Europe.

Those visitors who are interested in the history of the country can visit any of the 7 UNESCO World Heritage Sites. They are the Churches of Moldavia, the Dacian Fortress of the Orastie Mountains, the Historic Centre of Sighisoara, the Monastery of Horezu, the Villages with Fortified Churches in Transylvania, the Wooden Churches of Maramures, and the Danube Delta. Those visiting Bucharest can bask in the majesty of the Romanian Palace of Parliament in Bucharest, the largest, heaviest, and most expensive civil administration building on the planet. Those venturing a little deeper into the country can enjoy the castles, fortifications, or strongholds as well as preserved medieval Transylvanian cities or towns such as Cluj-Napoca, Sibiu, Braşov, Bistriţa, Mediaş, Cisnădie, and Sighişoara.

The Bran Castle, a national monument and landmark in Transylvania, is an especially intriguing piece of the country's history. It is commonly referred to as Dracula's Castle, the home of the titular character in Bram Stoker's seminal gothic horror novel, Dracula. Though there is little evidence to suggest that the writer was aware of the castle and its loose connection to Vlad the Impaler, the putative inspiration for Dracula, the myth has persisted. As a result, many tourists flock to the castle which is now a museum dedicated to displaying art and furniture collected by Queen Marie, the wife of King Ferdinand I and the last queen of Romania.

The video uploaded by Destination Paradise is almost 48 minutes long and has over five and a half thousand views that it has garnered in just over one month since it was uploaded. The comment section of the video is filled with viewers commending Destination Paradise on the production quality of the video. Many commenters also express the sentiment of being enamored by the country and wanting to visit it when they get the chance. Destination Paradise uploads many more such city drone videos, mountain drone videos, and beach drone videos from locations all around the world such as New York City, The Maldives, Africa, and many more.
