Storm damage preparations are vital particularly for the Wilmington area because forecasters have warned that an "above average" hurricane season is expected. Weather experts are forecasting with a 70 percent confidence level that three to five Category 3, 4, or 5 hurricanes will hit in 2021. According to the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), a "normal" hurricane season is composed of 14 named storms and seven hurricanes per season.

With such alarming predictions, homeowners and other property owners need to be on the alert since the Atlantic hurricane season, which affects the Wilmington area, runs from June 1st through November 30th.

The first thing to do is to get rid of dead tree branches because these can break off during a storm, posing danger to both people and property. It is also a good idea to shorten those tree branches that overhang the house, garage, etc. The strong wind can cause these branches to hit the roof or other parts of the home, possibly causing damage. Furthermore, overhanging tree branches often deposit leaves and seeds in the gutters, causing them to clog and overflow in a storm. A clogged gutter will cause rainwater to flow in unexpected places, possibly causing damage to the roof and walls.

A vulnerable part of homes and other properties are the windows. Thus, it is advisable to cover them with hurricane shutters or pre-cut plywood to protect the glass from the strong winds and flying debris. In the same manner, all shutters should be closed. And all outdoor furniture, trash cans, decorations and other items that can be sent by the strong winds flying toward to house or people, should be brought inside the house unless they can be securely tied down.

Water damage that can be caused by a storm is due to water that can't or doesn't drain properly. Thus, it is a good idea to keep the gutters clean. This should be done twice a year or even more if there are many trees near the home. The clear gutters will allow the rainwater to drain off the roof properly. Flooding and standing water can also occur in the yard because of landscape and grading issues. These must be remedied because a lawn that is submerged in water for a few days will suffocate and die. Homeowners will need to consult experts for the proper solutions. Possible solutions include adding soil to low areas, installing plastic drainage pipes, creating a French drain, and more.

Meanwhile, in the event that water damage may still occur, homeowners and other property owners can call on Bryter Restoration of Wilmington for fast water damage restoration.
