Personal injury can be defined as physical, mental or emotional hardship experienced by an individual. This definition excludes property, and the injury is often the result of either the direct actions, lack of action or negligence of a third party. Under local laws, a victim may file a claim to seek compensation from the party that caused their injury, and there are a number of ways in which they can seek compensation. Kenneth S. ?This settlement agreement means that the injured party will not be able to enter a lawsuit at a later date to receive future compensation for the injury should long-term or unforeseen issues arise as a result of the injury. It is important to ensure that the settlement agreement covers all current and future medical and other costs that may be related to the injury. It is highly recommended to only enter into a settlement agreement for a personal injury on the advice of a lawyer who will provide representation throughout the negotiation of the settlement. Lawsuits are another way in which a victim may seek compensation, and it involves going to court and presenting evidence of either physical or psychological injury aimed at proving that the respondent (the party that is allegedly responsible for injury) is actually responsible for the injury. A judge will hear the case and make a decision as to whether or not the respondent is required to pay the plaintiff a certain amount as compensation. In general, personal injury cases are taken to court when both parties fail to reach a settlement on their own.

It is important to have the right legal representation, especially when a personal injury case ends up going to court. ?While court cases for small claims may be decided very quickly, lawsuits can often be long, drawn out affairs that can become very expensive very quickly,? the personal injury firm says. ?Respondents often have insurance for personal injury suits that provide legal representation. In Valdosta, there are two basic types of compensation: compensatory damages and punitive damages. Compensatory damages include medical expenses, future medical care, loss of income, additional expenses, cancelled or altered plans and pain and suffering or mental anguish. Punitive damages are usually awarded at the court?s discretion as a result of wrongdoing or bad behavior by the respondent. They are awarded in addition to compensatory damages and offer a way to compel the respondent to pay for bad behavior.
