They realize that not everyone has the ability to go to a classroom to study for the California contractor license exam, so they have also a contractors home study program. They have books, study guides, and

The classroom curriculum that is available through the Contractors State License Center has six courses focused on the topic of Law and Trade. And the California contractor license exam is composed of two separate exams. One is the regular Law and Business test, which people need to pass if they want to qualify as a contractor in California.

Those who are successful in passing the Law and Business test must also take a second exam that is focused on the particular trade or certification area that they really want to focus in. This does not include the C-61 Limited Specialty Classification, which does not require passing a trade exam.

The exams for licensing contractors are in multiple-choice format, with the law exam made up of approximately 125 questions, while the length of the trade exam will vary depending on the specific classification. There are about 80 to 125 questions for the trade exam, on the average. Candidates will need to answer 73 percent of the questions correctly to pass the law exam.

The study materials provided by Contractors State License Center have been organized in a format that is easy to understand in order to make study process much simpler and easier. The test questions in the exam are actually modified frequently but this contractors license school has a full-time contractor on their staff who regularly performs research on the requirements for the test. This means that their Students actually get to know exactly what is required to pass the exam when they attend the classes, whether online or through a classroom environment, and the interactive practice tests.

For the in-school program, they provide six classes that tackle Law and Trade. The course has been designed in such a way that students will only need to come to class once a week for just two hours, with convenient weekend and evening class times. 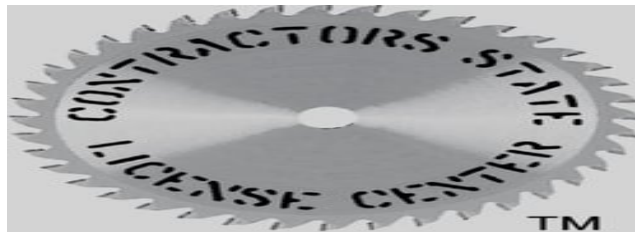
