Some of these lawn pests are chinch bugs, sod webworms and billbugs. Chinch bugs are small, black, hour-glass shaped bugs that feed on grass sap. They are quite hard to notice, but an attentive eye can see large groups of them in lawns. They may be small, but the damage they can cause is large as they inject their saliva into blades of grass. Meanwhile, sod webworms are tiny, wheat-colored moths that let their larvae feed on grass at night. This makes the grass grow dormant under heat stress or during droughts. Homeowners can tell that this is happening when sod webworms are flying around in their lawn. Similarly, billbugs lay their eggs in grass during spring. When these eggs hatch, grubs emerge and feed on the grass. This eventually leads to the death of grass.

These pests can be extremely stressful to deal with, but there are certain measures that homeowners can take to keep their lawn healthy and lower the chance of a lawn pest infestation occurring. To begin with, lawns must be watered deeply but infrequently. This can be done by letting sprinklers run slowly and making sure that the water is not running off. Grass seeds can also be sprinkled in thin areas during spring and fall. It is better to use grass species that are well-suited to the specific environment that they will be planted in. In addition, lawn fertilizers must be applied at the proper times. Lawns must also be aerated on a regular basis, and mowing should not cut down more than a third of the grass blade length.

However, even when all of these actions have been taken, pests may still be attracted to a homeowner's lawns. As such, it is still a good idea to invest in lawn pest treatment. Lawn pest treatment can be approached with a DIY mindset, but this is not recommended. Knowledge, skill and experience is needed to properly diagnose a lawn and execute an effective pest treatment. The best approach varies depending on the seasons, the lawn itself and several other factors.
