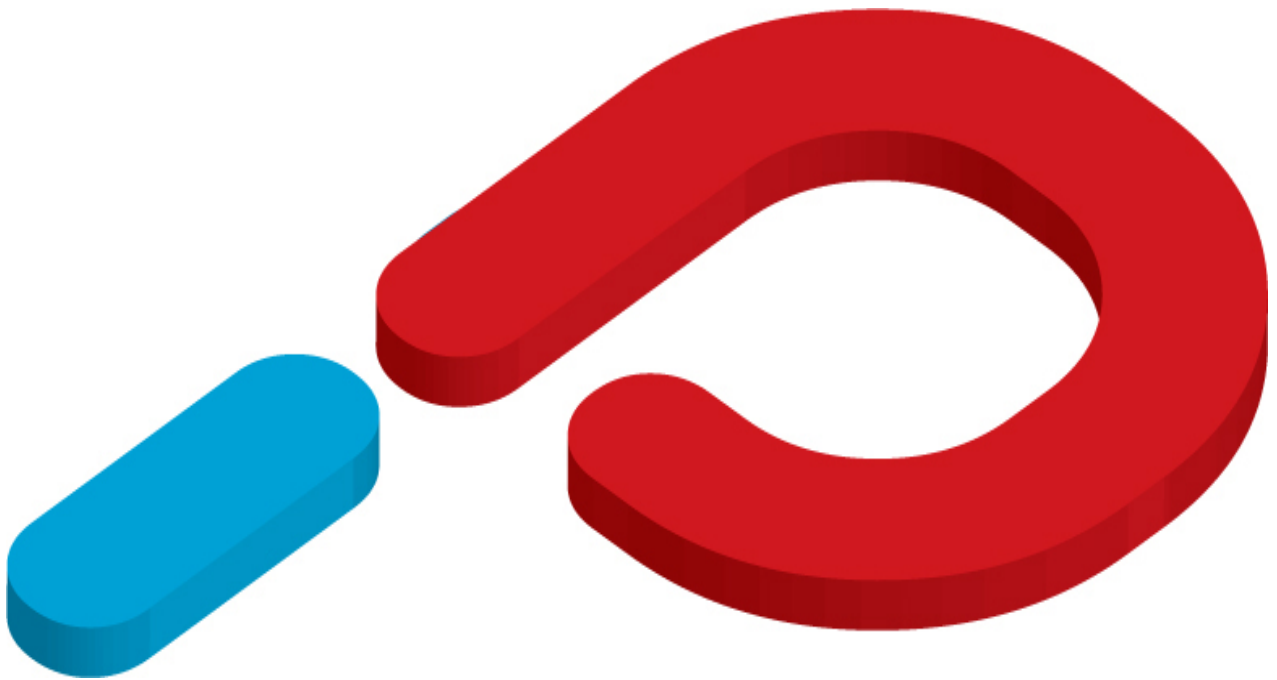




Sikh Or Hindu Wedding? Discerning Photographers Know
