Bexley Dentist Sheds Light On Teeth Implants

Zainab Ali of Bexley Dental says, "Whatever reason you lose your teeth for, whether it is due to a sports injury, bone loss or periodontal disease or something else entirely, having missing teeth will majorly affect your life. Not only will it limit how and what you eat, it will also ruin your smile and damage your self-esteem. At Bexley Dental, we take pride in helping our patients deal with missing teeth through a variety of implant options and are always glad to help anyone in need."

There are several other options to deal with missing teeth, such as dentures or bridges. However, Bexley Dental points out that neither of these options are permanent solutions. As they explain on their website, dentures are notoriously uncomfortable for all-day wear, and their reduced bite-strength means that, despite replacing the missing teeth, patients still tend to struggle to eat their favourite foods, and they may worry more about their dentures coming loose while they are speaking or enjoying a meal.

On the other hand, tooth-supported bridges have issues that begin from before they are even put in place. They require grinding down of healthy teeth on either side of the missing tooth, which will ruin healthy teeth in the process. It must be noted that there are resin-supported bridges that do not damage healthy teeth, but they cannot be used just in all circumstances. Given the thin bond used to attach resin-supported bridges, they should only be used on incisors so they are not subject to the torque and force of chewing.

This is where dental implants come in. Dental implants are metallic screw-shaped cylinders which are placed securely into the jawbone to replace the root and secure a replacement tooth. These are inserted directly into the jawbone and mimic the stimulation that the root of a natural tooth would provide to the bone, which allows implants to keep the bone strong and healthy, just like a real tooth ? thereby avoiding the bone loss that can accompany less permanent options. As dental implants are the closest thing to natural, healthy teeth and are permanent, convenient and cost effective, they are fast becoming the popular option for anyone seeking tooth replacement options both in Australia and around the world.

Bexley Dental offers permanent implants that let patients stop worrying and start smiling again. The dental clinic offers both individual implants and All-On-4 implants. Individual implants are used when a patient has a single tooth or multiple teeth that need to be replaced. These are usually one or two neighboring teeth. All-On-4 implants, on the other hand, are particularly suited to patients who require half or full sets of teeth replaced. As an entire set of teeth can be supported by just four implants, they are an excellent option for patients with periodontal or bone issues.
