If the water level in the home?s toilets is inconsistent with some running low while if others are on the verge of overflowing, it is possible that the sewer lines could be blocked. If the water doesn?t drain from sinks, showers, tubs, and toilets fast enough, it might be more than just a clogged drain as multiple pipes throughout the house are being affected. Other surefire signs of sewer line blockages include a distinct smell of sewage emanating from the bathrooms, uneven water pressure from the shower or taps, gurgling or bubbling noises every time the water is drained or flushed, persistently wet patches in the front yard or backyard with pools of water

The most obvious and commonly encountered reason is the presence of large solid objects getting stuck in the drain line and creating a hard blockage. Whether it be ignorance or carelessness, homeowners may end up dumping items down the drain that don?t break down easily. This can include a laundry list of household items such as tissues meant for facial use, thick paper napkins and paper towels, feminine hygiene products, diapers, and other cloth or paper products that claim to be flushable but are not immediately soluble in water. Dumping large quantities of leftover food or organic waste into the garbage disposal such as coffee grounds, cooking grease, eggshells or dense vegetable peels can cause it to collect and bunch together, creating a blockage that will need professional intervention to solve. The second reason that most sewer lines get clogged is the tendency for the roots of the trees on the property to extend and breach the walls of the pipes, and entangling the flushed waste to create blockages. Finally, older properties may have aging cast iron, cement, or clay piping that gives out and ends up breaking, cracking, and collapsing, leading to the entire plumbing system being unable to function.
