In Minnesota, the law on child support is based on the idea that a child has the right to benefit from the income of both parents, regardless of whether the parent is custodial or non-custodial. Therefore, they are concerned more about the income of the non-custodial parent rather than the specific need of the child. And even if the custodial parent happens to be well-off, or even a billionaire, the non-custodial parent is still mandated to pay child support according to Minnesota law. For this reason, Minnesota's child support guidelines are based on the income of the non-custodial parent. Although there are many factors to be

considered by the court of law in determining the actual amount of child support required, in most cases, the amount is calculated based on child support guidelines. Basically, the amount of child support is based on the non-custodial parent's net income and the number of children, with a cap of \$6,975.

Previously, spousal maintenance or alimony, was awarded to stay-at-home mothers. However, the courts had to reexamine spousal maintenance in view of the rise of dual-income households and changes in society. In some cases, child support and spousal maintenance issues are "reserved," which means that they will be considered at a later time and date. This will require additional legal assistance. For those who are being presented with a proposed settlement where child support and spousal maintenance will be reserved, it is advisable to check with an experienced lawyer to make sure it is the best option for their particular situation.
