



Personal Injury Attorney in Clarkesville GA Explains What Personal Injury Victims Can Do After Being Injured

A personal injury may result from various situations, including medical malpractice; defective equipment; unsafe medications; slip and fall; animal attacks; work-related injuries; vehicle or pedestrian accidents; nursing home abuse; unsafe premises security; birth-related injuries; and more. These situations may result in minor injuries or life-threatening conditions. Under such circumstances, the injured person can seek compensation under the law.

Jim Weidner, an attorney at Oliver & Weidner LLC, says, "When you have been injured as a result of the negligent act of another person or entity, you should do some things to ensure that you receive proper medical care and future compensation. Make sure to report the incident to the proper authorities, seek medical attention as soon as possible, write down a description of what happened, and get legal advice from a personal injury lawyer."

It is essential to report the incident to the proper authorities. For instance, when the accident happened in the workplace, it should be reported to the company's appropriate personnel so that the necessary documentation can be made regarding the event and Workers' Compensation can be notified. For those incidents that occur outside the workplace, these should be reported to the manager or person in charge of that particular building or establishment where the incident occurred. Public incidents, such as dog bites, car accidents, and the like, should be reported to the sheriff.

In addition, get medical treatment as quickly as possible. The person's health and welfare is the most important. Thus, it is advisable to seek medical attention as soon as possible when injured, or even when there is no evident injury since some injuries may not be apparent immediately after the accident. It is also important to comply with all of the medical advice provided by the doctor.

It is also a good idea for the personal injury victim to write a detailed description of what happened as soon after the incident as possible while the event is still fresh in the mind. Include names and contact information (if possible) for any witnesses to the incident.

Finally, seek legal advice from a personal injury lawyer in Clarkesville, GA. This attorney can make sure that the accident victim will be able to get all the compensation to which he or she is entitled under the law. The amount of compensation will depend on a number of factors, including the type of injury, the severity of the injury, and its outcome for the injured party.
