Generally speaking, HDRA explains that there are two ways to recover data after it has been lost. The first is to use a DIY method, which means that the individual will try to recover all files by themselves using a special software to locate important files on their computer or device. This can be done if there are no severe hardware problems involved with the device, but this may also mean that the device will be damaged during the process.
