For instance, it is much more difficult to check on body language and other visual cues when communicating in a virtual meeting. To ensure an orderly online meeting, a moderator should be identified and those who are not talking should mute their mic.

It is also a good rule not to speak when another person is talking and this is where the moderator can be useful. For instance, it can be agreed upon that those who want to speak should raise their hand and it would be the moderator's goal to ensure that each one is given a chance to talk.

Another way to enhance the virtual meeting experience is to have a backup plan when problems arise, such as people getting logged out unexpectedly, or drive failure. This will allow the managers to shift to the backup conferencing plan if technical problems impede videoconferencing. Meanwhile, managers and leaders will also need to take into account potential problems, such as "Zoom fatigue" and reduced productivity. Managers may tend to call for too many virtual meetings because of the ease of setting them up.
