People are advised to be aware of the contagion risk. As such, they should always wear slippers in public showers, locker rooms, and pool areas. Additionally, according to the clinic in Pembroke Pines plantar warts can be prevented by minimizing barefoot walking. This is believed to be one of the main reasons why people in South Florida develop the warts in the first place. Due to the temperature, people often choose not to wear shoes.

"Time and time again, I find myself having to explain to people that plantar warts really are incredibly contagious," adds Dr. Holder. "So often, a patient says they don't know where the warts came from, but then tell me that they shared sneakers or shoes with someone who has plantar warts as well. They must be aware of the risks to avoid reinfection."

A final tip given is that they must regularly get their shoes sterilized, particularly if they believe someone with plantar warts wore them. Paradigm Podiatry offers a shoe sterilization service in their clinic. For those who have developed plantar warts, the clinic offers laser treatment to have them removed. In addition to laser treatment for plantar warts, they also offer laser treatment for toenail fungus.
