suitable for withstanding thermal shock. Decades ago, the original formulation of the mainstream bakeware

brands was borosilicate glass, but the formulation was changed, most likely for the purpose of reducing

costs, and now tempered soda-lime glass is used and is the norm. As a result, however, this type of

bakeware is no longer able to withstand thermal stress, which can lead to it shattering, even several days

after it was last used.
