This affects every taxpayer and is a considerable drain on the Medicare program. The CMS (Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services) works with numerous private citizens, businesses, and organizations that administer Medicare reimbursements and file claims. They have to ultimately rely on these individuals and businesses to remain in compliance with the rules. Regrettably, numerous are not, and that number is growing. As a result of the government's shortage of resources and holding cheaters responsible, it has to often depend on individual healthcare workers in the market to come forward with information so they can hold those who defraud the program responsibly.

"Fraud against the Medicare program may take many forms," stated the Maine healthcare whistleblower lawyer "The Fraud can be manipulating healthcare records in order to earn more from Medicare, surcharging the government, supplying second-rate services, or products, and many other activities. The government depends on private whistleblowers to come forward with firsthand knowledge and documentation of this conduct and the government rewards them for their important support. Through qui tam suits, whistleblowers have the ability to bring civil claims against those celebrations on behalf of the government under the False Claims Act and can be rewarded for it."

The federal False Claims Act is a federal law that makes it illegal for any entity to make incorrect Medicare claims or otherwise defraud the federal government. It additionally makes it possible for a medical worker with information of scams against the Medicare program to file a whistleblower case on behalf of the federal government. In exchange for their information and effort, the whistleblowers may be entitled to gather rewards of between 15% to 30% of the funds recovered by the federal government. The act likewise has stipulations for whistleblower security against any employer retaliation which may result from filing a lawsuit or agreeing to work with the federal government.

When a whistleblower steps forward with relevant information relating to Medicare fraud, the case is submitted to a federal district court. It is put 'under seal' while the Department of Justice investigates the lawsuit and the proof speaks with witnesses and seeks advice from specialists and company workers. The government will then decide if it will step in. If it does not choose to step in, the whistleblower still may continue the case on their own.

Since healthcare workers may place themselves personally at risk doing this important work, the federal False Claims Act highly incentivizes them with a considerable part of the financial recuperation. In a successful claim, the federal government can recover as much as three times its losses to fraudulent activity in addition to penalties for each occurrence of fraud.
