He also touches on what certain specifications will mean for the end user, including the increased pixel density (which will result in a more crisp image) and the high refresh rate (which will make motion on-screen appear much smoother).

In an earlier review, Taylor also goes over the Samsung Galaxy Z Flip3 Smartphone. While his review does cover the phone's specifications and its unique folding mechanism, he understands that many in his audience may not be looking for a phone that folds, especially if it comes at the cost of other components that some may value more (such as the camera module) and features a relatively hefty price tag. Taylor's first priority is to ensure his audience has all the information "and context" they need to make purchases they will not regret.

"The issue with it is the screen and the folding," he elaborates. "There is a visible bump, but the problem is what it's going to be like in a year, what it's going to be like in two years." Taylor's long career also means that he has friends and sources from all over the industry, and he consulted with some of these sources to learn that many people were actually returning their Samsung Galaxy Z Flip3 devices because the screen was malfunctioning at the hinge. This led him to conclude that this flexible screen technology may need a few more generations of research before it is truly ready for a general audience. In turn, he recommends it more for those who do not mind experiencing such issues with their phone as their ultimate goal may be to simply have the most advanced device in their pocket. Conversely, he advises people against buying the Samsung Galaxy Z Flip3 if they are looking for a phone that is expected to last for at least a few years.
