The CMS (Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services) works with lots of individuals, companies, and entities that administer Medicare compensations and file claims. They have to rely upon that these private citizens and entities are in compliance with the laws. Sadly, many are not, and that number may be growing. Considering the government's lack of resources and holding cheaters liable, it has to rely on private healthcare employees in the industry to come forward with information so they can hold those who defraud the program responsibly.

"Fraud against the Medicare program can take many forms," said the Michigan healthcare whistleblower lawyer "It can be manipulating patient records to get paid more from Medicare, surcharging the government, providing substandard healthcare products or services, and many other activities. The government relies on private whistleblowers to come forward with direct knowledge and documentation of dishonest activities and the government compensates the whistleblowers for their vital support. Through qui tam lawsuits, whistleblowers have the ability to bring civil claims against those parties on behalf of the government under the False Claims Act and can be rewarded for it."

The federal False Claims Act is a federal law that makes it criminal for any business entity or person to make false Medicare claims or otherwise defraud the federal government. It additionally makes it possible for medical personnel with information of fraud against the Medicare program to submit a whistleblower lawsuit on behalf of the government. In exchange for their info and effort, the whistleblowers may be entitled to gather benefits of as much as 15 and 30 percent of the financial by the federal government. The act additionally has provisions for whistleblower shield against any company retribution that may result from filing a case or accepting work with the government.

When a whistleblower steps forward with information relating to Medicare fraud, the case is filed in federal district court. It is put 'under seal' while the Department of Justice investigates the claim and the evidence, interviews potential witnesses, and speaks with specialists and firm workers. The federal government will then decide if it will intervene. If the government does not, the whistleblower still may continue the case on their own.

Due to the fact that healthcare workers put themselves at risk doing this crucial work, the federal False Claims Act strongly incentivizes them with a significant portion of the monetary recuperation. In an effective claim, the federal government can recover approximately 3 times its losses to fraudulent activity as well as charges for each event of fraud.
