And the computer should always be placed on a stable surface and any position where the cord will not be a tripping hazard. It someone trips on the cable, the power connection could get damaged, or worse, the computer could fall down.

And it is a good idea to make sure that the PC is not too close to the wall. This will ensure that the hot air from the computer is being vented out efficiently, particularly if the exhausts are located at the back. Furthermore, the cables at the back can get bent too much and get damaged if it is too close to the wall. The article also offers the advice that the best way to position a PC is to place it parallel to the monitor and on a table or computer desk that is stable, with sufficient room for the cords and for airflow.
