Every year, the nationwide Medicare program loses billions of dollars because of the fraudulent activity committed by private citizens and organizations that deal with this program. This may affect every taxpayer and is a huge drain on the Medicare program. Arvind Bob Khurana, a prominent healthcare whistleblower lawyer, helps health care employees in Missouri who may have documentation of Medicare fraud bring civil lawsuits against these entities on behalf of the government. The CMS (Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services) works with numerous people, businesses, and entities that administer Medicare compensations and file claims. They need to trust that individuals and companies remain in compliance with the regulations. Sadly, many are not in compliance, and that number is getting bigger. As a result of the government's lack of resources and holding cheaters accountable, the government must depend on private healthcare employees in the market to come forward with information so they can hold those who defraud the program responsible.

"Fraud against the Medicare program may take many forms," said the Missouri healthcare whistleblower lawyer "The Fraud can be adjusting healthcare records to get paid more from Medicare, surcharging the government, providing second-rate healthcare services, or products, or many other things. The government counts on private whistleblowers to come forward with direct knowledge and evidence of dishonest activities and the government rewards them for their crucial assistance. Through qui tam claims, whistleblowers have the ability to bring civil claims against those parties on behalf of the government under the False Claims Act and can be rewarded for it."

The federal False Claims Act is a federal law that renders it criminal for anybody to make incorrect Medicare claims or otherwise defraud the federal government. It additionally makes it possible for a health care employee with information of fraudulent activity against the Medicare program to file a whistleblower lawsuit on behalf of the government. In exchange for their information and effort, the whistleblowers may be entitled to gather incentives of as much as 15 to 30% of the recovery by the federal government. The act additionally has regulations for whistleblower security against any employer retribution that results from submitting a claim or consenting to a deal with the government.

When a whistleblower comes forward with information and facts relating to Medicare scams, the case is filed in federal district court. It is put 'under seal' while the Department of Justice investigates the claim and the proof, speaks with potential witnesses, and seeks advice from experts and agency workers. The government will then make a decision if it will intervene. If the government does not choose to participate, the whistleblower still may continue the case by themselves.

Since healthcare employees may place themselves at peril doing this important work, the federal False Claims Act particularly incentivizes them with a substantial portion of the monetary recovery. In a successful claim, the government can recover up to three times its losses to fraudulent activity in addition to charges for each event of fraud.
