Under the National Energy Customer Framework (NECF), householders and small business customers can access a range of schemes, including subsidies, rebates and concessions.

These schemes are designed to help eligible consumers pay for energy costs such as electricity, gas and solar PV systems installation. It is also worth noting that the NECF requires retailers to disclose essential information to customers to ensure they are informed about their contracts' prices, discounts, and terms and conditions.
