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Every year, the nationwide Medicare program may lose significant funds because of fraudulent activity perpetrated by individuals and companies that work with this program. This affects every taxpayer and is a substantial drain on the Medicare program. The CMS (Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services) contracts with numerous individuals, businesses, and entities that manage Medicare compensations and process claims. The CMS has to essentially rely on that these people and businesses remain in compliance with the laws. Regrettably, numerous entities are not, and that number is getting bigger. Considering the government's shortage of resources to police and hold defrauders accountable, the government has to count on private healthcare workers in the market to come forward with information so they can hold those who defraud the program responsibly.

"Fraud against the Medicare program can take many forms," stated the Nebraska healthcare whistleblower lawyer "It can include adjusting healthcare records to get paid more from Medicare, surcharging the government, supplying subpar services or products, or any other activities. The government relies on private whistleblowers to come forward with firsthand knowledge and proof of dishonest activities and the government compensates the whistleblowers for their important help. Through qui tam suits, whistleblowers have the ability to bring civil claims against those celebrations on behalf of the government under the False Claims Act and can be rewarded for it."

The federal False Claims Act is a federal law that renders it criminal for any entity to make false Medicare claims or otherwise defraud the federal government. It also enables healthcare personnel with information of scams against the Medicare program to submit a whistleblower claim on behalf of the government. In exchange for their info and effort, the whistleblowers are entitled to collect benefits of between 15 and 30 percent of the financial by the government. The act likewise has regulations for whistleblower protection against any company retribution that results from filing a case or accepting work with the federal government.

When a whistleblower comes forward with relevant information relating to Medicare fraud, the case is filed in federal district court. It is put 'under seal' while the Department of Justice examines the lawsuit and the proof speaks with potential witnesses and seeks advice from experts and firm personnel. The federal government will then decide if it will step in. If it does not choose to participate, the whistleblower still may continue the case by themselves.

Because health care employees place themselves personally at peril doing this important work, the federal False Claims Act particularly incentivizes the potential whistleblowers with a considerable portion of the financial recovery. In an effective claim, the government can recover approximately 3 times its losses in addition to charges for each incident of scams.
