Local authorities responded to the surge by imposing a curfew and ordering restaurants to shutter their indoor dining services, leading to massive layoffs. The same pattern repeated over summer 2021 as visitors emboldened by vaccinations once again flocked to the city's many beaches and social venues.

As the year progressed, Florida was able to push back against the rising number of coronavirus cases. It has successfully managed to play its part in battling the pandemic as, as of the time of writing, its vaccination rate stands at 61.5% which is higher than the national average of 59.9%. Though the numbers fare better than just over half of the states in the country, it is no cause for celebration as there is still a long way to go towards completely containing the virus and returning the state's economy to the level it was at before the pandemic began.

According to statistics from the US Bureau of Labor, Miami had recorded a 15% drop in total nonfarm employment in April 2020, 2% higher than the national average for the same time period, when the pandemic was just beginning. In 2021, however, the numbers don't spell all doom and gloom. Despite the initial hammering that the state's economy took, it is bouncing back as a result of the state government's efforts to control the spread of the virus. The employment numbers gradually improved over the rest of 2020 and 2021. The Miami metropolitan area saw over 119 thousand new jobs added between September 2020 and September 2021. The leisure and hospitality industry saw the largest gains followed by professional and business services, and trade, transportation, and utilities.

The pandemic affected the livelihoods of a huge swath of the city and county's population. Those who found themselves out of work were left in dire straits with no means to provide for basic necessities like rent, food, and utilities. Towards the end of 2020, authorities in Miami-Dade County were hard at work providing those in need, the funds allocated by the federal CARES Act. By mid-November 2020, it had managed to help around 12,000 households with the office being continuously inundated with applications. The application period was closed and reopened several times to give the administration time to keep up with the demand.
