It is important to note that the conventional approach to replacing teeth with an arch is by having 8 or more implants but this has certain limitations and is typically a more expensive alternative. In contrast, there is the All on 4 approach, which is an innovative technique that will only need 4 implants to provide support for a full arch of teeth. It is the All on 4 technique that is offered at Bexley Dental because of its various benefits.

Dr. Theo Spyrakis, founder of Bexley Dental and an expert in the All on 4 technique, explains, ?All on 4 is an advanced dental implant technique. It is one of the methods used for full mouth implants, where the whole set of upper or lower teeth is replaced. However, instead of needing an implant for each of them, they are supported with just four implants. The conventional procedure to replace a full arch of teeth requires eight or more implants but this has the limitation of having to put implants in those areas where there is reduced bone density at the back of the mouth. As a remedy for this, sinus augmentation and bone grafting may be needed to strengthen the jaw bone, which is a much more invasive procedure. But with All on 4, only two implants are required at the back of the mouth, which can be angled at 45 degrees to avoid bone-deficient areas.?

All on 4 has several distinct advantages over the conventional method for full mouth implants. These include: the fact that only four implants are required to support a full arch of teeth; elimination of the need for bone grafting; the fact that it is a less invasive procedure, thus reducing the healing and rehabilitation process; the fact that it is a much faster procedure; more flexibility in terms of design and in the optimum replacement of teeth; the fact that it doesn?t need the same bone density to secure the implant; and the fact that the patient gets new fixed teeth in just 24 hours after surgery.

Meanwhile, at Bexley Dental, Dr. Spyrakis is mostly focused on the All on 4 treatment and has performed more than 550 All on 4 and single dental implant procedures each year. As such, Dr. Spyrakis has developed

disease or tooth loss.
