Estimates indicate that approximately one in 15 people have sleep apnea and that 80 percent who have the condition are undiagnosed. The problem is that if the condition is left untreated, it can result into potentially life-threatening health issues, such as stroke and other heart conditions.

A representative for Insurance Covered CPAP says, "A CPAP machine can help a sleep apnea patient by helping keep the airways open through the use of mild air pressure. This can prevent the airways from collapsing when the patient is sleeping. This can result into a better sleep, which offers various health benefits, such as improved brain function, weight loss, stress reduction, cancer prevention, inflammation reduction, and more."

A CPAP machine has a compressor that produces a continuous stream of pressurized air that goes through

an air filter and goes to the patient through a mask that is sealed around the mouth and nose. A possible negative feature of a CPAP machine is that the patient may require some time to get used to wearing the mask during sleep. However, the potential benefits for the sleep apnea patient are substantial. These include: improvement of the quality of sleep; reduction and even possible elimination of snoring; assurance that the airway remains open while the patient is asleep; reduction of high blood pressure; and reduction or even elimination of sleepiness during the daytime.
