Automatic CPAP machines allow for automatic pressure adjustment through a sensor that senses when a sleep apnea event is about to happen and responds by increasing the air pressure sufficiently to relieve it. After this event has passed, the device automatically brings down the pressure to a more comfortable level. The Bi-PAP machine offers various pressure settings for both the inhale and exhale breathing cycles.

It is also provided with intelligent features, including automatically detecting sleep onset and automatically adjusting the pressure to the lowest level required for treatment.

Examples of Auto-CPAP machines available for Insurance Covered CPAP are the AirSense 10 Autoset with HumidAir and ClimateLineAir Tube from ResMed, DreamStation 2 Auto CPAP from Philips Respironics, Luna II Auto CPAP from 3B Medical, and Resvent iBreeze Auto CPAP from Resvent. Automatic CPAP machines may be needed by some patients because standard CPAP machines may sometimes cause excessive dryness and difficulties in breathing against the pressure exerted by the machine. Because Auto-CPAP machines automatically increase the pressure only when a sleep apnea event is about to occur and reduces the pressure after the event has passed, patients may find them to be more comfortable.

Examples of Bi-PAP machine available for Insurance Covered CPAP are the AirCurve 10 VAuto with HumidAir and ClimateLineAir from ResMed and the Luna Bi-PAP from 3B Medical. Bi-PAP machines are the most sophisticated forms of CPAP machines. They are typically reserved for patients who cannot tolerate the standard or even the automatic CPAP machines. For instance, the AirCurve 10 bilevel machines?have?two pressure level settings: higher pressure when the patient inhales and a lower pressure when the patient exhales. The Luna Bi-PAP has automatic humidity control while the AirCurve has an integrated humidifier.
