According to an article shared in Business Standard, when a vehicle arrives at Maruti Suzuki Toyota India, it will first be inspected, and ?it will then be sent for pre-treatment and de-pollution and parts and aggregates like batteries and airbags will be extracted to ensure zero discharge. Thereafter it will proceed for dismantling in accordance with international best practices and processing, and segregation of scrap material will take place. The vehicle shell will be compressed into a bale to ensure easy storage and transportation.?
