Re-roofing has various advantages. First of all, re-roofing requires common commercial roofing materials, such as BUR and single-ply roofing materials that include thermoplastic polyolefin (TPO), rubber roofs, or

polyvinyl chloride (PVC) roofs. Thus, property owners are always assured that their roofing projects can be done properly because reliable roofers are sure to have in-depth experience in installing such roofing materials. Roofing experts, such as Cox Roofing Systems, have developed tested and reliable installation procedures for such roofing materials that are assured to work properly. Single-ply and BUR roofing materials have minor regulatory standards. Re-roofing materials also require a complete teardown and removal of the whole roof when a repair is needed. Furthermore, roofers will not be able to patch up major damages in single-ply and BUR roofing.

With regards to roof restoration, one important advantage is rapid installation. This is because professional tri-thermal roof installations, using the best industry equipment, allow the quickest possible roof restorations. Tri-thermal roofs become fully operational within 48 to 72 hours after installation. Roofing projects that need multiple-layer applications can be completed within two weeks. On the other hand, a roof restoration project may need some roof improvements. Roof improvements will be needed if the present roofing has weak foundations.
