The quality of the final roofing materials to be installed will also significantly add to the total cost. The cost to tear off the original roof is included in the cost to replace it.

All throughout the United States, and especially in Northern Ohio, asphalt shingles are the most common type of roofing due to their versatility in design options, affordable cost, and durability.
