That's a bad thing because asbestos has been linked to such terrible illnesses as asbestosis, pleural disease, and mesothelioma. That's also why the owner of ABC Environmental Contracting Services, Dan Benton, wanted to go over the different ways that they can detect the presence of asbestos in homes and buildings. He says, "Most people are surprised when they learn the lengthy list of building materials that once had asbestos added to them. These same people are even more surprised to learn that although there is no such thing as an acceptable level of asbestos exposure, this substance has not been totally banned for use in America. The older your home is, the more likely you are to have asbestos-containing materials in it. A few simple tests that are done by us can tell you whether you have an asbestos issue in your home or business that you need to be concerned about."

Benton stated that asbestos was such a popular building product additive due to its relatively low cost, fire resistance, and versatility. With that much use, he encourages every homeowner to at least consider having

their home tested for asbestos. This becomes even more important for owners of older homes who are about to do any type of renovations. That's because it is so easy to put dangerous asbestos fibers into the air during the renovation process. The company owner then went on to describe the different tests that they use to detect the presence of asbestos in a home or building. This includes taking air samples around a home or business. It's a process that uses what's known as Phase Contrast Microscopy (PCM) to detect asbestos fiber concentrations in a sample of air. Customers often prefer it to other asbestos testing methods because it is less invasive, costs less, and is the fastest asbestos testing method. In some of the more difficult detection cases, an alternate method called Transmission Electron Microscopy (TEM) may also be used to test air samples. He also talked about how they can take samples of the different building materials in a home that are most likely to contain asbestos. Once a sample has been collected, it is then tested by using a method called Polarized Light Microscopy (PLM). It has the benefit of not only being able to identify fibers but also to identify the asbestos types that are associated with them. Soil and Water Testing is also very commonly used by them to detect the presence of asbestos around a home or building. These tests are also run using either PLM or TEM testing methods. Benton mentioned that their asbestos testing is very reliable and that's important because it's the key to coming up with a sound asbestos removal plan for a home or business owner.
