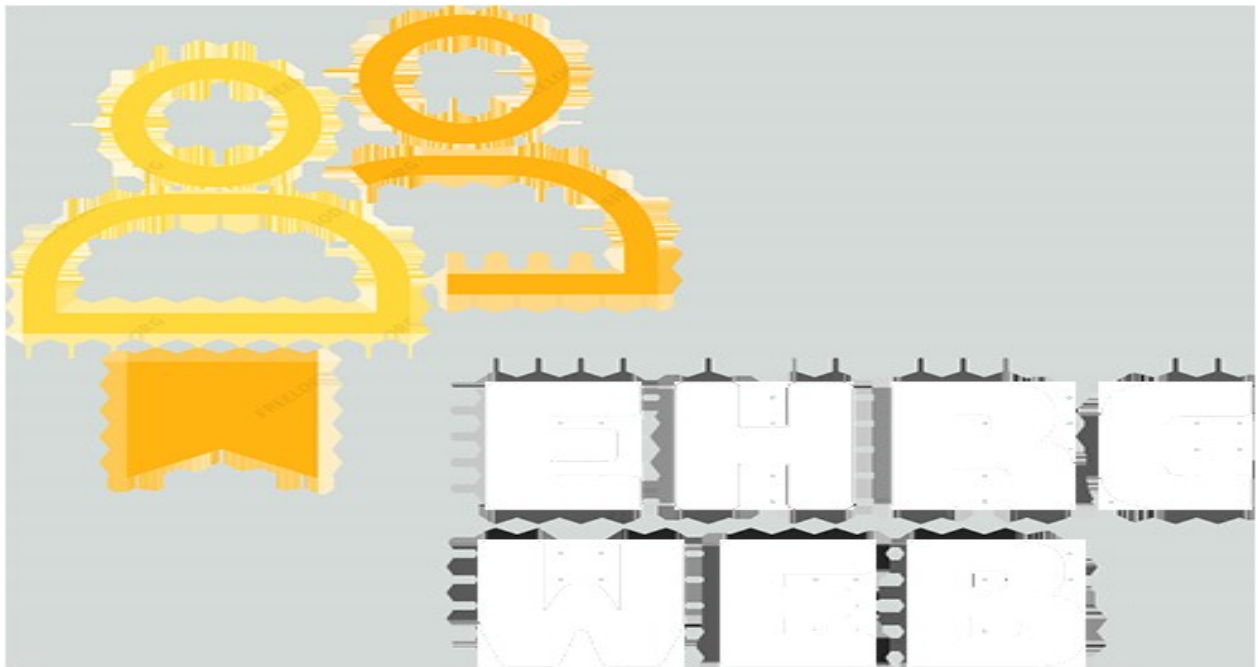




EHRC Web Releases New Report That Discusses The Law Regarding Domestic Violence

It is a grave and complex problem that has been taken seriously by the criminal justice system and the public at large. The publication analyzes how the law works for domestic violence cases in the United States. The experts in the report explained how the offender is punished if found guilty in court.

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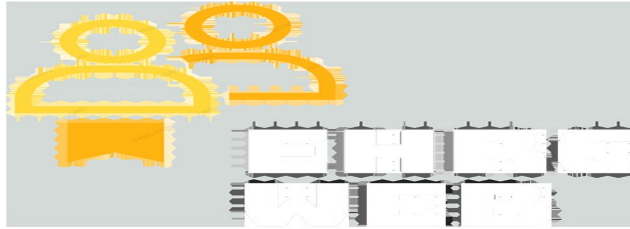
