The cosmetic dentist in Canberra explains that this is because cosmetic dentistry is concerned with enhancing the aesthetics of the teeth and this includes the colour, shape, position, size, and alignment of the teeth. Cosmetic dentistry focuses on improving the aesthetics of your teeth, including the colour, position, shape, size and alignment. And, all of that goes towards giving you the best possible smile. What?s more, while not

every type of cosmetic dentistry improves the functionality of your teeth, many of them do. Cosmetic dentistry is pretty advanced nowadays, with more durable and natural-looking treatments than ever before.?

These include: CEREC dental crowns; white dental fillings; inlays and onlays; crowns and bridges; teeth whitening; and dental veneers. CEREC technology has revolutionised the method used for tooth restorations. This is because a 3D digital scan of the tooth or teeth is taken using the CEREC machine. This allows the patient to actually see the images on the screen and fully comprehend the treatment to be provided. The CEREC machine will then produce the dental crown or whatever is required to restore the tooth or teeth. After this, all that the dentist will need to do is polish and then fit the restoration, providing the patient with a much improved smile. A key improvement that CEREC technology offers is its speed. The restoration is made available within the same day, while with the previous method, the patient would have to wait for weeks.

Another important cosmetic dental service provided is white dental fillings, which will be used to replace the conventional silver amalgam fillings. Amalgam fillings have the disadvantage of being very noticeable. At present, composite resin fillings have been developed that matches the colour of the tooth enamel, which means they will appear natural. In addition, composite fillings appear to be more stable and more durable. Furthermore, the mercury in the amalgam fillings have potential harmful effects. In the same way, porcelain is now being used for inlays and onlays rather than gold, which ensures that these are no longer as noticeable as before.
