Auto-CPAP machines available through Insurance Covered CPAP include the DreamStation 2 Auto CPAP from Philips Respironics, Luna II Auto CPAP from 3B Medical, AirSense 10 Autoset with HumidAir and ClimateLineAir Tube from ResMed, and Resvent iBreeze Auto CPAP from Resvent. Automatic CPAP machines may be preferred by some patients because standard CPAP machines may sometimes cause too much dryness and they may find it difficult to breathe against the pressure exerted by the machine. Auto-CPAP machines automatically increase the pressure only when a sleep apnea event is about to occur and then decrease the pressure after the event has passed. Thus, some patients may prefer auto-CPAP machines.

Also available from Insurance Covered CPAP are Bi-PAP machines, such as the Luna Bi-PAP from 3B Medical and the AirCurve 10 VAuto with HumidAir and ClimateLineAir from ResMed. Bi-PAP machines are actually the most sophisticated type of CPAP machines. They are often reserved for patients who find the standard or even the automatic CPAP machines uncomfortable to use. For example, the AirCurve 10 bilevel machines?have?two pressure level settings: higher pressure when the patient inhales and a lower pressure when the patient exhales.
