A survival garden is designed to provide people with nutrient and calorie dense fruits and vegetables to sustain the family in the event that there is a major disaster, which results into a lack of food because there would be no available food from the markets and groceries. It is also possible to create a medicinal survival garden instead if one is concerned about medicine and there are no longer any pharmacies that people can go to. Whether someone is living in a condo, a New York apartment, or a home in a rural area, there is a suitable survival garden layout for each situation.

The number one survival garden layout, according to Bug Out Bill, is the container garden. Although the container garden is not really a layout, it is the simplest way that can be used by everybody to have a garden, especially those who are beginners when it comes to gardening. A container garden is made up of plants growing on a container and this is a setup that is perfect for people have limited space, such as a small yard, a driveway, or a balcony. And although it can be used for those with a limited space, it is also possible to grow various kinds of crops. Bug Out Bill recommends creating a garden tower or stackable planters for a vertical garden. For instance, a five-tier stackable planter is recommended for those living in a condo and only have a balcony to use and they can also have one garden tower but this will allow them to harvest 15 plants each time. The number two survival garden layout, according to Bug Out Bill, is the raised beds. A raised bed is a

mound of soil that is placed on top of an existing soil. This can be surrounded by various kinds of borders or fences. One of the advantages of using raised beds is the capability to control the garden soil for the plants. This is beneficial particularly if the surrounding soil is not suitable for planting. In addition, it is possible to contain compost and fertilized soil in just one place rather than putting them in an open space where the soil can get washed away or eroded or trampled upon. The raised bed is also suitable for those who have a small backyard. Companion planting, which is close planting different plants to allow them to help each other grow, may be practiced for this set up.

The number three survival garden layout, according to Bug Out Bill, is the homestead layout. This layout employs the strategy of making the most out of the surrounding land around one's home. It does not only involve growing various kinds of plants but also raising animals, including chickens, goats, and even cattle. This allows for self-sustainable living, which means this is truly a survival garden layout. However, it will require a bit more planning compared to the other gardening layouts. A homestead will typically have fruit trees, nut trees, and perennial plants such as berries, banana trees, apple trees, mint, and more. Thus, it is essential to plan the various plant groups that will be included in the homestead. Ideally, a homestead would be suitable for rural areas. However, it can also be done for those living in urban areas by maximizing the use of the balcony and window spaces.
