To begin with, the clinic firmly urges their community to avoid simply going for the cheapest offering they can find. While cost is a consideration for many individuals and families, Bexley Dental cautions that a lower price may indicate a corresponding reduction in quality, and it is most inadvisable for patients to take such chances with their teeth. This is due to the fact that virtually all of the factors that influence the cost of the procedure have to do with the quality of the service being offered.

For instance, patients should be aware that their dentist's education can vary wildly from their peers. While it is true that every dentist undergoes the same primary education at dentistry school, this mostly enables them to perform general dentistry. Following this, however, they must specialize in certain fields, which in practice means that the post-graduate education for performing advanced procedures for one dentist can be very different to what another has received. This is notably applicable for dental implants as well.

Bexley Dental explains that some dentists may elect to take a short course, spanning no more than a few days, to learn the basics of performing dental implants. Alternatively, they can undergo an intensive postgraduate course that includes clinical, theoretical and practical education as well as a great deal of first-hand experience in a variety of cases. Both qualify a dentist to perform the procedure (since they already have a foundation in general dentistry), but the latter enables them to offer much more personalized care. The clinic says these dentists will be able to take each patient's unique condition into account and plan their treatment around expected challenges as a result. This greatly minimizes the risk of complications occurring during the procedure.

The second factor that influences the cost of the procedure is the quality of the materials being used in the implant. Here, too, there is great variety, and a patient may find that the most attractive quotes they receive from certain dental care providers can unfortunately also mean that cheaper materials will be utilized throughout their treatment.

According to the clinic, the quality of the materials used can affect the implant's overall stability and longevity. This means that it is more likely to come loose, in turn making the implant more likely to fracture or causing bone loss in the surrounding tissue due to trauma. If the implant fails to this degree, it will have to be surgically removed and replaced. As a result, taking the cheapest option here may result in the patient having to pay twice for the same procedure. The best option is to ask for brand name implants from reputable manufacturers.

The final factor patient's should take into account is their dentist's experience with the All On 4 procedure. The difference between a general dentistry practitioner and an implant expert who specializes in the field is easily distinguishable since they have a great deal more experience with this specific type of procedure ? in addition to experience dealing with the unique needs of each of their patients. Since they spend more time developing personalized treatment plans, specialists are better equipped to identify and address any other issues their patients may present with.

Bexley Dental recommends that patients ask their dentists about each of these factors to determine whether the procedure they offer is worth its cost. An understanding of their dentist's training and the tools they use can help the patient determine whether their procedure will be done right the first time, thereby eliminating the need to pay again in the future for another attempt.
