Their reliability drops off a cliff once they have been installed for a few decades, depending on the type of roofing materials. So, if you have moved into a house that is not newly constructed, you should anticipate having to pay for a new roof in the first 5 to 10 years of your residence and start saving up for it.?

They are extremely heavy but they last a very long time and rarely need to be replaced. They are made from non-combustible materials and are very energy-efficient. However, their heft and weight make them difficult to install, they don't work in all climates, and they often require additional framing for installation.
