



Podiatrist in Spring Hill Florida Offers New Treatments for Plantar Wart Removal

The Saorsa Swift System is a microwave therapy device that produces microwaves that can be used for the treatment for skin lesions and warts, particularly the plantar warts that are on the heels and other parts of the feet that bear weight. Just like other warts, plantars are caused by the human papillomavirus (HPV). The problem with plantar warts is that they can be painful as a result of their location where there is pressure exerted on them. Dr. Adamov says, "Swift is a cutting edge, FDA cleared technology that has proven to be highly effective in the removal of plantar warts. It delivers low dose microwave energy through a specialized probe that targets and effectively treats the underlying HPV virus by stimulating a natural immune response in the body. We like to say that we're addressing the root cause; not the symptom."

The Swift system utilizes the power of the patient's immune system in order to focus on the root cause of the problem, which is the HPV virus. Because of this, it has a substantially higher efficacy compared to other

treatment methods. The pain felt during the Swift treatment is dependent on the patient and the lesion being treated. This pain or discomfort felt by the patient is caused by the rapid rise in temperature of the infected tissue when the high--power microwaves are directed at them for 2 seconds. The pain or discomfort will then subside almost immediately after the energy delivery is stopped. There is very little post procedural pain and all patients have reported that they were able to resume their daily chores right after the treatment.

Dr. Adamov advises patients to come for a consultation if they feel or believe they have a plantar wart and want it removed. There are a number of common symptoms to look out for, including: pain felt when the sides of the wart are pressed; circular flat spot on the skin with a depressed portion in the middle; the feeling of "painful pebbles" in one's shoes; presence of small black dots; lesion on one's foot has changed color or is painful and bleeding; warts appearing "yellowed" with a crust; discomfort that prevents the performance of regular activities; poor sensation on the feet; wart reoccurs and multiples after trying some treatments; and patient is unsure if the lesion is a wart. Meanwhile, a fungal toenail can cause a lot of irritation and discomfort if left untreated. It can also spread to the other nails. It is particularly dangerous for patients who have diabetes or a weak immune system. Thus, it is advisable to call the podiatric practice at the first sign of any thickening, discoloration, or deformity of the toenails. Depending on the specific case, they can provide various effective methods of care, such as topically applied medications, surgical procedures, and oral antifungal drugs.
