Because of their low incomes, SSDI recipients often cannot afford the rental market in the United States. During the processing of disability claims, many people become homeless. In all cases, the agency does not offer housing or rent assistance to recipients of disability benefits. Federal housing assistance programs are available, however. This publication addresses the need for housing assistance for people with disabilities by examining these programs.

According to NJDDC, the report was produced after in-depth research by their experts. The report's primary focus is programs that provide affordable housing to disabled Americans. The new article further sheds light

on two such federal programs and how they help people requiring assistance. The experts in the report discussed the issues people with disabilities face when looking for housing and offered advice to ease the process.
