A grease interceptor, also known by other names such as a grease catcher or a grease separator, has the primary purpose of trapping FOG before it enters the wastewater

disposal system. It traps the sludge and lets it rest for a while it separates into three layers ? an upper layer made up of oils that are lighter than water, an intermediate water layer, and a bottom layer for solid waste. Some grease interceptors also have strainers that make it easy to collect and dispose of solid waste.

Grease traps are a nice-to-have for residential homes, but they are deemed essential for commercial establishments that make and serve food. Due to the sheer volume of cooking that happens in kitchens at restaurants and other commercial properties that serve food, having a grease trap on the property is non-negotiable. In many cities, local laws require the installation of a grease trap on properties owned by commercial or institutional food-service providers. For example, the Dallas City Code, Chapter 19, Sec 19-126.2 (c) specifies all grease traps must be completely emptied and cleaned by a licensed hauler. The interceptors must be cleaned as often as necessary but not less than every 90 days, or whenever 25% or more of the interceptor contains floating materials, sediment, oils, or grease. When it comes to maintaining a grease trap, businesses can rely on the services offered by professionals, such as those at North Texas Plumbing, to ensure the long-term health of their property?s plumbing.

A spokesperson for North Texas Plumbing talks about the need for grease trap maintenance services by saying, ?Though there are several reasons why plumbing can eventually fail such as age, corrosive ground conditions, or the unchecked growth of roots from trees on the property which breach the pipes, the specter of dealing with FOG is different.
